**Abstract:** The collection is mainly comprised of administrative and educational papers. It also holds publications produced by the society as well as publications and research proposals submitted by members of the Adelphi chapter. In addition it contains financial records, applications, scrapbooks, memorabilia and photographs created by the Alpha Omega chapter beginning with its inception in 1970.

### **Biographical History**

Sigma Theta Tau International was founded at what eventually became known as the Indiana University School of Nursing in 1922. Since its inception it has fostered and enabled research in the field of nursing. The name of the society is often abbreviated as STTI. It is known for the high ideals which it supports and the opportunities it provides its members, through collaboration on initiatives through its various chapters. The fundamental principles of the society are to promote superior scholarship, leadership, high standards, creative work and to “strengthen commitment on the part of individuals to the ideals and purposes of the nursing profession.” Membership is open to baccalaureate and graduate nursing students who demonstrate excellence in scholarship and to nurse leaders with superior levels of achievement. The society provides more than \$650,000 annually for nursing grants, scholarships and monetary awards. The Adelphi University chapter, Sigma Theta Tau Alpha Omega, founded in 1970 provides a unique experience by keeping members current on trends in the field of nursing and providing opportunities for research through grants and the opportunity to be a part of initiatives both at Adelphi and as part of international initiatives.

## **Scope and Content**

The collection holds 55 boxes and items of varying sizes. These include boxes of folders, scrap books, and memorabilia. The scrapbooks contain information about a variety of aspects of the chapter dating from the 1970s until 2011. Included in the collection are administrative papers, publications produced by the society and chapter, as well as records of the induction of new members, research proposals, correspondence, educational materials including workshops and presentations, and prospective member application packages. Finally the memorabilia consists of a framed picture of the Sigma Theta Tau founders, signature books, photographs and several plaques and media. The media primarily consists of some floppy disks, VHS and DVDs. These include: The International 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Commemorative, The Induction and Installation to the Chapter from May 1990, We Band of Angels by Dr. Elizabeth Norman, and a Conversation with Virginia Henderson on Founders Day Celebration from October 1991.

## **Series Description of the Collection**

### **Series 1: Administrative**

The Administrative series contains information about the operational aspects of the society and the Alpha Omega Chapter. It includes the minutes of the board of directors, executive board and executive committee meetings. Also included are records of the by-laws and annual reports from Sigma Theta Tau International and also from the Alpha Omega Chapter. Documents about the guidelines, goals and initiatives of the chapter also give insight into the functioning of the chapter. A Delegate Report on the 41<sup>st</sup> Biennial Convention also demonstrates the global significance of the society. There are several folders dedicated to the induction of new members. Finally also included are lists of chapter dates and itineraries as well as information about regional members and associations.
